The Policy of it All

- Based upon flexible conceptual hurdles to be overcome and not...
- Legalistic and overly bureaucratic processes
- Facilitative of bona fide commercial and other socially advantageous activity
- Three undercurrents:
 1. Protection of local jobs
 2. Promotion of 'Welcome Investment'
 3. Security
- Mainland residents have an extra hurdle to jump

What Can You Do As a Visitor?

Genuine business visit – leave and depart quickly

Pre-relocation for business residence: orientation, preliminary – but no assumption of the job-related duties

Trade fair participation, speaking at conferences

Delineated by the attitude of the HKID to a prosecution for the activity in question/intention of the parties at the outset

No change in the last 10 years.

Employment Visa Based On a **Job Offer**
- Approvability Test -



" Does the applicant possess a special skill, knowledge or experience which are of value to and not readily available in Hong Kong? "

Moreover, the Immigration Department will:

" take into consideration, amongst other things, whether it is justified for the employer to bring in an expatriate staff. "



The Business Investment Visa
- Approvability Test -

Will the Business be of Substantial
Benefit to Hong Kong as a Whole?



The Business Investment Visa Catch 22

- Test = showing benefit to Hong Kong
- Can't join in a business until HKID consent secured
- Can't secure consent of HKID until you show benefit to HKID
- Can't show benefit without joining in a business
- Can't join in a business until HKID consent secured!

Dependant children

Unmarried partner

Same sex partner





Why Do Applications Get Denied?



Case fatally flawed from the outset

1. Pillars of Approval are weak
2. Security considerations
3. Not approvable *ab initio* (e.g. One Year Rule)
4. Related prior denials or poor history

Poor preparation and approvability analysis

Insufficient supporting documentation

Requests of the HKID not afforded the requisite level of importance

Your 'Reconsideration' application to be based upon:

"New and Previously Unsubmitted Information"

- No emotional appeals
- No mere rehash of the original argument
- No shuffling of the first set of papers



Trying Again?

A solid Reconsideration application requires:

- Significant additional new information adding weight to the original application and/or
- Relevant and important new facts which have come to light since the refusal
- Comprehensive verifying documentation in support

If case has merit, the Process takes between 6 and 16 weeks – if not, usually 10 days to 2 weeks

One Man Investment Visa for Hong Kong?

Approvability Test = "Substantial Contribution to the Economy of Hong Kong"

Visitor
If you're entirely new to Hong Kong the process is extremely challenging unless your plan is exceptionally well researched

Resident
Current residents with 3-4 years history in Hong Kong tend to have an easier time persuading the HKTD of the merits of your plan

Human Capital
If you have discrete experience or a professional background in an obscure discipline this is a very positive factor

Cash Needed?
6 months' operating cash in the company bank account & sufficient back up capital on hand personally

Apply Onshore or Offshore?

Suitable Business Accomodation
Must meet business needs

Local Employees
Create new jobs within 6-12 months

Business Plan
A specific document is not actually required but you have to clearly articulate your commercial intentions

Financial Projections
Detailed 12 months' required supported by overview to 36 months

Other Resources?

The Major Considerations For Approvability

Key Takeaways

1. Exceptional human capital is as good as cash in the bank
2. Some string businesses struggle to get approved
3. Local jobs MUST be in the offing
4. 'Cutting edge' industries are especially welcomed

Use Form IDPPA Application Form & IDPVB Sponsorship Form

The Process Will Take 3-4 Months to Complete From Beginning to End

Submit your application on the 24/F of Immigration Tower [or send by mail to the 2/F Receipt & Dispatch Unit].

Expect to have to undergo several exchanges of correspondence each time submitting further & better particulars and supporting documentation

If approved, you will receive a visa label valid for 12 months

Progressing Your Application

Business Review
If your application was marginally approved, the HKTD might subject your business to a complete Review at the time of your first extension 12 months later






About

These templates are suitable for business investment visa applications submitted either within Hong Kong ("in-country") or from outside of Hong Kong or by mail direct to the HKID ("out-of-country").

Template	Used For
BIV Cover Letter with Document List	To apply for a business investment visa with provision to include dependant visa applications for legal dependant family members
BIV Subsequent Submission Letter	To answer follow up queries of the HKID.
BIV Interim Reply Request Letter	To request an interim reply from the HKID if you have not heard from them for several weeks.
BIV Approval Processing Letter	To complete the application approval formalities. This is used where the application has been considered on an in-country Change of Status or Change of Category basis (not required for out-of-country applications).
BIV Appointment of an Authorised Representative	Where you need to appoint a third party to submit papers or progress your application at the HKID on your behalf.


